



CAMP RULES

Reservations

- We are not open for check in and check out on: New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, Easter Sunday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day. As a result, we require a three-day (two-night) minimum stay during these holidays.
- Accommodations are available for those who would like their family's dogs to stay together. The daily discounted rate for each additional dog in the same cabin (size/breed and accommodation limitations may apply) is \$18.

Check in/ check out

- Check in and check out are by appointment only between the hours of 9:00 AM and 6:00 PM
- Rates are per calendar day. There is always a charge for the first and last day of stay.
- Any dogs scheduled for departure but not picked up by 6 PM will remain a camper of Camp Good Stay and you will be charged the daily fee of \$35.

Health Care

- The health and safety of each camper is our number one priority; therefore, every dog must have an overnight camper profile form completed prior to his/her stay. This profile helps us understand your dog's background, personality, and special needs so we can make his/her visit as safe and comfortable as possible.
- All campers must be in good health and must not have had or been exposed to any contagious or communicable illness within a 30-day period prior to check-in. Camp Good Stay advises against boarding campers that have a terminal illness and are in the late stages of that illness.
- Dogs showing signs of vomiting, coughing, gagging, sneezing or diarrhea may not be admitted or maybe transfer to a veterinarian clinic for proper care.
- Campers must possess a temperament that allows camp counselors to be able to properly care for them. Allowances may be made for specific temperament issues, but dogs cannot pose a danger to camp counselors. Please discuss potential temperament issues with Camp Good Stay prior to boarding your dog.
- We do not allow "In season" canines to stay at Camp Good Stay and you will have to seek other accommodations.

Vaccination Requirements

- In the best interest of all, each camper must meet our published vaccination standards before admission. Dogs requiring vaccination updates must have the vaccine administered no less than three days before an overnight stay. Individual circumstances may be considered with written documentation from a veterinarian. Titers are accepted with proper documentation. We do not accept owner administered vaccines.
- Puppies must be at least nine weeks of age and have completed their first two series of vaccinations, including the Bordetella vaccine and a fecal exam. Puppies over 18 weeks of age must have their full series of vaccinations, including the rabies vaccine.
- It is the owner's responsibility to ensure we have updated vaccination records prior to boarding.

Dogs:

Rabies: Current in the last year

DHLPP: Current in the last year

BORDETELLA: Current in the last 6mo. (preferred) 1yr. (req.)

CANINE INFLUENZA: Current in the last year (recommended, not required)

Food, Medications and Exercise

- We require that you provide your own food to keep your dogs diet consistent. Generally, dogs kept on a consistent diet avoid upset stomachs while boarding. In the event the food you provide runs out prior to checkout, we will purchase more food and you will be billed the expense. We feed twice daily – approximately 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
- Camp good stay will administer oral and topical medications. All medications should be provided by owner and clearly labeled with written instructions, including medication name, dogs name, dosage, and when the medication should be given. Campers requiring specialized care, hand feeding, walking assistance, pee pee pads, etc. Are handled on a case by case basis and may be subject to a daily fee.
- It is standard for each camper to go outside into our fenced in free play area four to five times per day.

Belongings

We encourage you to bring an unwashed, disposable T-shirt to help reduce separation anxiety, and you may bring your pets bed, blanket, and favorite toy. Please do not bring anything that cannot be washed in a washing machine and dried in the dryer. We are not responsible for lost or damaged belongings.

General

- Camp Good Stay reserves the right to refuse admission to any dog for any reason, at any time, who lacks proof of vaccinations, displays signs of untreated or potentially dangerous conditions, demonstrates aggressive behavior or who fails to meet our standard health and temperament policies.
- Camp Good Stay accepts cash, personal check, Visa, MasterCard, and Discover Card. Return checks, regardless of reason, or subject to a fee of \$25.
- Our prices, policies, services, and hours are not negotiable and are subject to availability and change without notice.
